

Add Tens to a Number



Check Understanding

Find $66 + 20$. Explain what you did.

What You Need

- number cube (1–6)
- 12 game markers of one color, 12 of another color
- Game Board
- Recording Sheet

What You Do

1. Take turns. Roll the number cube. Find the number next to the toss.
2. Roll the number cube again. Add this number of tens to your number. For example, roll a 4 and add 40.
3. Write the addition sentence on the **Recording Sheet**.
4. Cover the answer on the **Game Board** with a game marker. If that number is taken, your turn ends.
5. Play until one partner gets three markers in a row.

Toss	Number
1	14
2	27
3	33
4	14
5	27
6	Lose a Turn
