
### Add Tens to a Number

### **What You Need**

- number cube (1-6)
- 12 game markers of one color, 12 of another color



- Game Board
- Recording Sheet

#### **What You Do**

- 1. Take turns. Roll the number cube. Find the number next to the toss.
- 2. Roll the number cube again. Add this number of tens to your number. For example, roll a 4 and add 40.
- 3. Write the addition sentence on the **Recording Sheet.**
- **4.** Cover the answer on the **Game Board** with a game marker. If that number is taken, your turn ends.
- **5.** Play until one partner gets three markers in a row.
