VAPOR

liquid in the air in the form of a gas

PRECIPITATION

any form of water that falls from clouds onto Earth's surface

EVAPORATION

the change of a substance from a liquid to a gas (vapor)

CLOUDS

a collection of millions of tiny water droplets or ice crystals

DEW

condensation that occurs outdoors due to warmer air striking a colder surface

CONDENSATION

Water vapor that cools and Changes back into a liquid

TEMPERATURE

A measurement of how hot or cold something is

WATER CYCLE

A continuous movement of water into the air and ground, onto and over land, and back

RUN-OFF

Precipitation that isn't absorbed by the soil and flows over the surface of the ground

AQUIFIERS

Porous layers of rock that can hold water
