- Keep your students together; do not allow students to explore unattended.


## BEHAVIOR:

- Prevent students from running, climbing, or acting recklessly in the museum.


## LEARNING:


- Ask the students' teacher about the learning goals for the day.
- Encourage students to explore and interact with exhibits productively.


