WHILE AT THE LEONARDO, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR STUDENTS':

SAFETY:

- ▶ Stay with your students and know their names.
- ▶ Keep your students together; do not allow students to explore unattended.

BEHAVIOR:

- ▶ Be respectful of museum staff and other guests.
- ▶ Encourage students to pick up after themselves and leave spaces as neat as they found them.
- ▶ Prevent students from running, climbing, or acting recklessly in the museum.

LEARNING:

- ▶ Ask the students' teacher about the learning goals for the day.
- ▶ Encourage students to explore and interact with exhibits productively.
