

Animals and Habitats Diorama Project

Due date: April 21 2015

We will display these in our class for the whole School, and parents, to view. This will take place Thursday, April 23 9:00-10:30. This should be a lot of fun!

Things you will need:

- ★ A box (a shoe box works great)
- * Glue, tape
- ★ Scissors
- * Paper, fabric, or another type of material to cover the outside of the box and to decorate the inside
- ★ Ideas for other materials you may want to use- aquarium gravel, rocks, sand, dirt, twigs, plastic wrap, plastic bushes or trees, clipart, cotton balls for clouds in the sky, magazine pictures, pipe cleaners, paint, toothpicks-BE CREATIVEIII
- ★ You may print some animal pictures from clip art or the Internet for the inside or outside of your box.
- 1. Cover the outside of your box with paper. Decorate the outside with pictures and information about your animal and landform. Be sure to tell which geographic region of the state your animal/habitat can be found.
- 2. Use paper and other materials inside the box to make a replica of your animal's habitat.
- 3. The last step is to put your animal into its habitat inside the box. Try to make the figures 3-D using either plastic animal shapes, toothpicks to make your pictures stand up, or any other way you can devise. Include pictures or figures of other animals living in the same habitat and examples of foods in the animal's diet.

Attached is a copy of the rubric that will be used to grade your diorama.

If you want to make a 100, be sure to include all of the information in each of the 25 point boxes.
