

Animal Dioramas

You will need to answer the following question on or in the diorama:

- 1. Why is this habitat suitable for your habitat? Include information about your habitat.
- 2. How does your animal's physical characteristics help it meet its basic needs? (ex. How is the body covering helpful? How does it move?)
- 3. How do the animal's behaviors and reactions help meet its basic needs? (ex. How does it catch its food? How does it hide? How does it survive?)

Things you will need:

- A shoebox or other smaller box (not to exceed the size of a student desk.)
- Glue/Tape
- Scissors
- Paper, fabric, or another type of material to cover the outside of the box and to decorate the inside.
- Ideas for other materials you may want to use- aquarium gravel, rocks, sand, dirt, twigs, plastic wrap, plastic plants or animal figures, clipart, cotton balls, magazine pictures, pipe cleaners, paint, toothpicks, BE CREATIVE!
- You may print animal pictures from clip art of the internet for the inside or outside of your box.

The entire box must be covered, inside and out. 2D and 3D materials should be seen. Outside box- include information to answer questions #2 and #3 above. Inside box- include information to answer question #1 above
