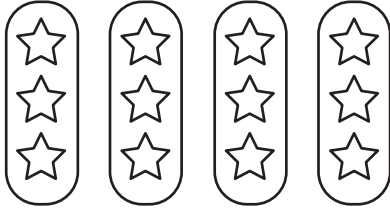


## Lesson 2 Reteach

### *Multiplication as Repeated Addition*

When there is an equal number in each group, you can find the total by using repeated addition or multiplication.



Multiply: 4 groups of 3 = 12  
 $4 \times 3 = 12$

Add:  $3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12$

**Write an addition sentence and a multiplication sentence for each.**



$6 + 6 + 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

3 groups of 6 =  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

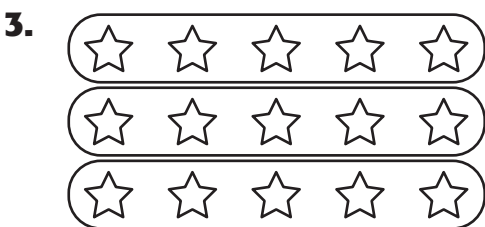
$3 \times 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
