### Trick-or-Reading Halloween Project

Parents and students,

It is time for our annual October reading project, Trick-or-Reading!

Here are the details:

1. Pumpkin Book Report: *Students must read a book (chapter or picture) and create a pumpkin that looks like the main character from their book. Students can carve, paint, dress or otherwise decorate their pumpkin in any manner they choose.*
2. *Students will create a tri-fold poster to display with their pumpkin. Included on poster should be: the setting, characters, main problem, solution, and their favorite part(s) of the book. Tri-folds also need to contain the name and author of the book. (Walmart has inexpensive tri-folds)*
3. Student MAY also dress up as a main character from their book but are not required to do so. Please DO NOT invest a lot of money on a costume. Instead use things from around the house and be creative.

The fourth grades will be holding an open house on Thursday, October 30th from 9:00- 10:30 for K-third grade classes at Quest. During the open house students will display their poster, their pumpkin, and answer questions about their book. Parents are welcome to attend as well. Students should come to school in costume!! (*IF* they decided to dress as the character from their book) Students cannot stay in their costumes all day, they will be given time to change after the open house.

Tri-fold posters and pumpkins are due Wednesday October 29<sup>th</sup>.  
Open house is scheduled for Thursday October 30<sup>th</sup> 9:00-10:30
