Rules:

Class Dojo

Make sure to sign up for a parent account on ClassDojo. I use Classroom Dojo as a way to track student behavior. I also use it to post photos of fun things we may be doing in the classroom. Information will be sent home with your child later for an account.

Absences:

Absences happen! If you know you will be absent, please inform the office. Work that needs to be made up will be left on your child's desk and it is their responsibility to get the work done. They may take it home and work on it as

homework if needed to get the work done. Not all missed work can be sent home and some will need to be completed in school.

Birthdays:

Quest is a no food school. Do not feel obligated to send any kind of treat with your child. Birthdays will be acknowledged in class. If your child is having a party, please send invitations by mail to avoid hurt feelings by those not invited.

Homework:

Homework will be assigned and completed online. At the beginning of each week, the assignments will be listed on the classroom blog. We also use Google classroom as a format to complete some assignments. Ipads, computers, and even smartphones can be used to complete most homework assignments.

Grading:

Grades are updated weekly. You can get a parent sign in if you do not have one at the front office. If your child is behind in more than two missing assignments I will notify you by email. Be sure that the email you give the school to contact you is an email that you check often.

Mastery Grading:

Quest has gone to an assessment based system for grading.

100-90% - 4 means the student has Mastery of a skill

89-80% - 3 means the student has Proficiency

79-60% - 2 means the student is approaching proficiency

59-0% - 1 means the student does not meet the standard
