## Divide with 0 and 1

| When you divide any number (except 0 ) by itself, the quotient is 1 . | When you divide any number by 1 , the quotient is the original number. | When you divide 0 by any number (except 0 ), the quotient is 0 . |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Kelly has 5 model rockets in 5 different boxes. How many model rockets are in each box? $5 \div 5=1$ <br> There is 1 rocket in each box. | Kelly wants to put 1 model rocket on each shelf. <br> She has 5 model rockets. <br> How many shelves does she need? $5 \div 1=5$ <br> She needs 5 shelves. | Kelly has 3 boxes and no model rockets. How many rockets are in each box? $0 \div 3=0$ <br> There are no rockets in any of the boxes. <br> Remember: You cannot divide a number by 0 . |
