
Reteach Lesson 8

Divide with 0 and 1

When you divide any number (except 0) by itself, the quotient is 1.	When you divide any number by 1, the quotient is the original number.	When you divide 0 by any number (except 0), the quotient is 0.
Kelly has 5 model rockets in 5 different boxes. How many model rockets are in each box? $5 \div 5 = 1$	Kelly wants to put 1 model rocket on each shelf. She has 5 model rockets.	Kelly has 3 boxes and no model rockets. How many rockets are in each box? $0 \div 3 = 0$
There is 1 rocket in each box.	How many shelves does she need?	There are no rockets in any of the boxes.
	5 ÷ 1 = 5	<i>Remember</i> : You cannot divide a number by 0.
	She needs 5 shelves.	

Use models to divide.
