Multiply by 11 and 12

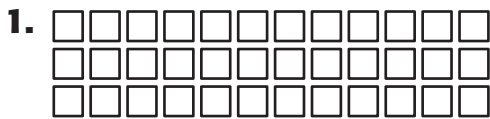
You can use facts and strategies you already know to help you multiply by 11 and 12.

Find 11×4 by adding 10×4 and 1×4 .

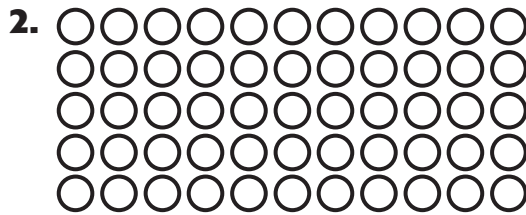


You know that $10 \times 4 = 40$, and $1 \times 4 = 4$. When you add the sums together, you see that $11 \times 4 = 44$.

Use models or patterns to multiply.

$11 \times 5 = \underline{55}$
