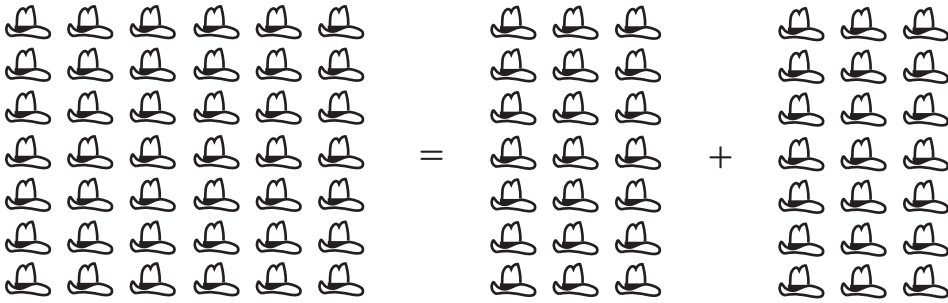


# Lesson 1 Reteach

## Multiply by 6

You can use facts that you already know to help you multiply by 6.

Find  $7 \times 6$  by doubling  $7 \times 3$ .

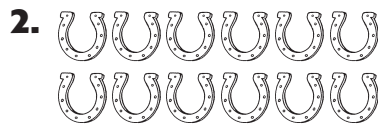


$$\begin{array}{rclcl}
 7 \text{ groups of } 6 & = & 7 \text{ groups of } 3 & \text{plus} & 7 \text{ groups of } 3 \\
 7 \times 6 & = & 7 \times 3 & + & 7 \times 3 \\
 & = & 21 & + & 21 \\
 & = & 42 & & \text{So, } 7 \times 6 = 42.
 \end{array}$$

Write a multiplication sentence for the picture.



$4 \times 6 = 24$



$2 \times 6 = 12$



$3 \times 6 = 18$
