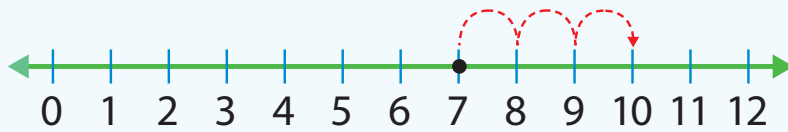
### Use a Number Line to Add
