tens	ones
2	1
1	8

21 is greater than 18.

$$21 > 18$$

less than ($<$)

tens	ones
5	9
6	0

59 is less than 60.

$$59 < 60$$

equal to =

tens	ones
2	4
2	4

24 is equal to 24.

$$24 = 24$$
