### Homework Helper



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You can group numbers and add in any order. Look for the doubles. Look for numbers that make a ten.

$$6 + 4 + 4$$

8

4 + 4 is a double.  
4 + 4 = 8.  
Then add 6 + 8

$$6 + 8 = 14$$

$$6 + 4 + 4$$

10

6 + 4 makes a 10.  
Then add 10 + 4

$$10 + 4 = 14$$
