### *The Distributive Property*

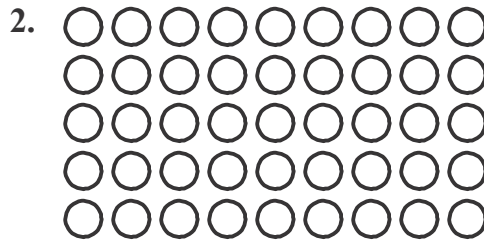
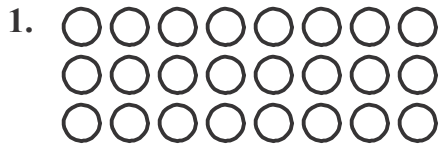
You can use smaller facts you already know to help you find larger facts.

**Find  $7 \times 4$  by adding  $5 \times 4$  and  $2 \times 4$ .**



You know that  $5 \times 4 = 20$ , and  $2 \times 4 = 8$ . When you add the sums together, you see that  $7 \times 4 = 28$ .
