The Distributive Property

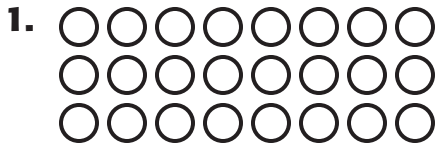
You can use smaller facts you already know to help you find larger facts.

Find 7×4 by adding 5×4 and 2×4 .

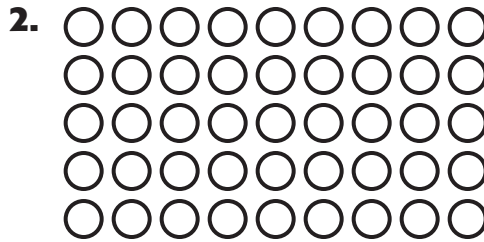


You know that $5 \times 4 = 20$, and $2 \times 4 = 8$. When you add the sums together, you see that $7 \times 4 = 28$.

Use smaller facts to find larger facts.
