

## Lesson 7 Reteach

### Write Equations

An *equation*, or number sentence, uses an equals sign to show that two expressions are equal. Here are some examples of true number sentences.

$$7 + 8 = 15$$

$$5 + 2 + 1 = 8$$

$$15 - 5 = 10$$

**Write +, −, or a number in the box to complete each equation. Remember to read each equation from left to right.**

1.  $9 + 5 = \boxed{3} + 7 + 4$

2.  $4,925 = 6,604 \boxed{-} 1,679$

3.  $34 \boxed{-} 7 = 9 + 9 + 9$

4. 55 rounded to the nearest ten =  $40 + \boxed{20}$

5.  $3 + 4 = 18 - \boxed{11}$

6.  $30¢ + 40¢ = \boxed{70¢}$

7.  $500 + 70 \boxed{+} 6 = 630 - 54$

8.  $100 - 30 = \boxed{15} + 25 + 30$

9.  $222 - 2 - 0 = 110 \boxed{+} 100 + 10$

10.  $24 \boxed{-} 8 = 16$
