DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT FOR MISS YOUNG'S 3RD GRADE CLASS OF 2018 — 2019

I am so happy to be here at Quest Academy! I look forward to getting to know you and your child this year. I hope that we can work together to make this the best school year possible for our 3rd graders!

CURRICULUM: Our focus as a class will be on the Utah State Core Curriculum. You have access to standards at: www.schools.utah.gov/curr/core.

CLASSROOM RULES: There are five basic rules in our classroom:

- 1. Eyes on Miss Young when she is speaking
- 2. Follow directions the first time
- 3. Do your very best
- 4. Raise your hand silently and wait patiently
- 5. Respect Miss Young, classmates, and yourself

HOMEWORK: Students will be responsible for reading 20 minutes a night for homework. Reflex Math will also be assigned for math practice throughout the week.

READING: This will consist of a variety of different reading techniques. 1. <u>Classroom Reading:</u> We will work with words using phonics to decode words. We will also be reading to each other in small cooperative groups and pairs. 2. <u>Silent Reading:</u> Students will have the opportunity to read silently. 3. <u>Whole Group Instruction:</u> During whole group instruction we will be using the Wonders reading program. 4. <u>Novel Reading:</u> I will read to the class daily from some of my favorite novels. We will complete many novels this year! 5. <u>Guided Reading Groups:</u> Each group of students will meet with me or one of our support teachers to do a guided reading lesson while the other students are rotating through literacy centers.

MATH: Students are required to memorize multiplication facts in third grade so there may be some additional practice sent home.

TECHNOLOGY: Quest Academy provides a technology rich environment. Technology is used daily to teach the curriculum. To learn more about Quest's Technology Curriculum please visit the school website/Our School/Curriculum.

GRADING: Students will be assessed informally as well as formally. Tests are given on all days of the week. However, most spelling, vocabulary, and grammar tests are given on Fridays. Grades will be updated regularly for your review online. Please contact the office staff if you need assistance in accessing the online grades.

Understanding where students are in relation to mastery of Common Core standards helps teachers and parents know if students need additional help, if students are proficient, or if students need further enrichment. At Quest Academy, students' grades are determined by student performance on various grade level assessments. Students are given multiple opportunities to demonstrate mastery and proficiency of standards. For example, if a student receives a below proficiency score, he/she will not only be retaught, but will also have the opportunity to raise his/her score by retaking the assessment multiple times throughout the term. We are excited for the implementation of this model and for the opportunities that will be offered our students for academic growth.

Elementary Grading Scale

- 4 100%-90% The student demonstrates mastery of the standard (can apply and teach).
- 3 89%-80% The student demonstrates proficiency of the standard.
- 2 79%-60% The student is approaching proficiency...
- 1 59%-0% The student is well below proficiency.
- 0 0% Refusal

MAKE-UP WORK: If a test is missed, the student will receive a reasonable time period to make up the test with the teacher's assistance. Not all class experiences can be made up at home so other assignments may be given to replace missed class time.

REWARD AND DISCIPLINE SYSTEM: Our class will be a money system to track behavior. Money will be rewarded and revoked according to behavior. Their money will be saved in their banks for an opportunity to "buy" privileges and prizes at the end of each week.

Money System

I can earn money for...

- Being on time
- Turing in homework on time
- Completing work on time
- Keeping desk area clean
- Good behavior
- Completing my job

I will pay money for...

- Using the bathroom during instruction
- Being tardy
- Sharpening pencil during instruction
- Late homework
- Not doing my job
- Misbehaving
- Messy desk area

RESTROOM PROCEDURES: Students should use the restroom before school, lunch recess, and afternoon recess. Please encourage your child to use the restroom during these times so that the classroom learning and teaching is not interrupted. I am very understanding in emergency situations. Students will be required to pay from their bank to use the bathroom during teach time. I also have students use the restroom during centers each day.

UNIFORM POLICY: See the Quest Academy Parent Handbook for the policy. Please ensure that your student is in compliance with the school uniform policy.

DONATIONS: In order to enrich your child's educational experience, I ask for voluntary donations of supplies. This year, for a small donation I will be compiling the beginning of the school year supplies. There may be additional

needed items throughout the year, such as tissues or Clorox Wipes. Prizes for the weekly store are also very appreciated. Additionally, donation of your time is critical to the class. A sign-up sheet will be provided on back-to-school night and will be available on the blog.

BIRTHDAYS: If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday by sending items to school, you may bring <u>non-food items</u> for all of the students in the class to be distributed toward the end of the day. Summer birthdays will be celebrated in the last month of the school year (May). Do NOT send birthday invitations to school unless you are inviting the whole class.
