



The data is the same in both graphs. The graphs show reading is the preferred weekend activity of the teachers surveyed.




1. Complete the bar graph using the data from the scaled picture graph. Write one sentence about the data in the graphs.





2. Complete the scaled picture graph using the data from the bar graph. Write one sentence about the data in the graphs.








Problem Solving
