



The data is the same in both graphs. The graphs show reading is the preferred weekend activity of the teachers surveyed.




**1.** Complete the bar graph using the data from the scaled picture graph. Write one sentence about the data in the graphs.





**2.** Complete the scaled picture graph using the data from the bar graph. Write one sentence about the data in the graphs.




