# Solve

<u>Mackenzie</u>	<u>Zoe</u>
26	19
+ 31	+ 33
57	52

$$57 - 52 = 5$$

The difference between the total number of ribbons for each girl is 5.

### Does your answer make sense? Explain.

Yes; Use the inverse operation of addition. 5 + 52 = 57 shows the answer is correct.


