

Important Parking Lot Info!

ONE WAY

Parents! <u>DO NOT park</u> on 4000 South in front of the houses south of the school to pick up or drop off your students!!

There are signs posted there which indicate NO PARKING and the Weber County Sheriff's Office WILL and has been issuing citations to those who park their cars there. <u>DO NOT</u> walk your children <u>ACROSS 4000 S to</u> your vehicle. There is no crosswalk and you could certainly be issued a citation from the police. <u>Please</u> pull into the parking lot and use the stacking lane stalls or park. Also, <u>a reminder</u> not to let your children out of the car while in the stacking lanes. Please be patient and wait for your turn.

The school parking lot is ONE WAY. Please drive through the

parking lot East to West.
