Just to relieve your mind a little bit, I will be picking up the majority of the student's needed supplies, and asking for $\$ 5.00$ to cover what I pick up. These supplies will include: 1 box of 12 Colored Pencils, 1 box of 24 Crayons, 2 composition notebooks, 1 spiral notebook, 2 mechanical pencils, 1 pencil top eraser, a view binder and 3 pocket folders. You can pay the $\$ 5.00$ to the front office.

If possible, please pick up the following items for your student:


- 1 Pencil Pouch large enough to hold a BOX of 12 colored pencils and a BOX of 24 crayons (Please make sure to choose a good size pouch with a great zipper. The zipper makes all the difference)
- 2 fine tip dry erase markers
- 1 Highlighter (The color of your choice)
- 3 Glue sticks (Elmer's work the best)
- A sturdy set of headphones
- A large box of Tissues
- A roll of Paper Towels
- 7 mm Lead for Mechanical Pencils
- 1 Sharpie Fine Tip marker
- 1 Lid from a CoolWhip Container (Brand doesn't matter as long as it is the same type of lid as the Cool Whip Lids)
- Size 7 mm lead

Throughout the year, your child will need lead for their mechanical pencils. During the year I may ask for donations of other items as we need them.

We may also ask for donations for fieldtrips as needed.
Always remember that all of these things are SUGGESTED school supplies and donations. No student will be singled out for not having something and will always have access to the requested items when needed.


Please DO NOT purchase or send large binders, personal pencil sharpeners, markers, scissors, rulers or liquid glue with your student. I have all of these items and will provide them to the students when needed.

When the students and I are organized, it makes our classroom environment a wonderful place to learn.
