Salute

Students will work in groups of three. One child is the Major. The Major shuffles the cards (digits 1-9). The other two children draw one card from the Major and hold it against their chest, without looking at it. When the General says, "Salute", the two children with cards put their card on their forehead so the Major and the other child can see it. The Major multiplies the two numbers together, using mental math skills, and they says the product. The first child to identify their OWN number, is the winner of that round and they gather both cards and set them in a pile. The child that has accumulated the greatest number of cards at the end of play is the winner. The children take turns being the Major.
